### **GOD'S WORK, OUR HANDS**

The "God's Work, Our Hands" program was initiated in 2013 to unite ELCA congregations in the celebration of the 25th anniversary of the ELCA. The thrust of the program is best described in an article by Bishop Mark Hanson for *The Lutheran* October 2008. Hanson wrote, "We do God's work, not because God needs us to do so, but because our neighbor does. We do God's work in Christ's name for the life of the world." It is an opportunity to celebrate who we are as representative of the ELCA in our service and love of our neighbors and our community.

These service activities offer us an opportunity to explore one of our most basic tenets as Lutherans, All of life in Jesus Christ--every act of service in every daily calling in every corner of life flows freely from a living confidence in God's never failing grace. These acts of Godly service have no need for recognition. They do not desire to be the center of attention as an individual or as a group. Godly service has no need to be noticed or thanked at all. The service is focused on the person or persons served, not on the agenda of the server.

Each year we at St. Matthew, under the guidance of the Mission and Ministry Committee, participate in projects for the benefit of our community. These projects improve the quality of life for groups and individuals in Columbus, Georgia. These acts of service are tangible demonstrations of our love for both our neighbors and our community.

We as a congregation will celebrate our unity in service with a potluck dinner after our morning worship service on September 14th. The meal will be followed by our two service projects for God's Work, Our Hands. We will be labelling paperback books for the USO library at Ft. Benning. We will be filling care bags for Wynnton Neighborhood Network. Each care bag will contain a bar of soap, toilet paper, and laundry pods. The care bags are distributed with food items provided to 525 clients served each month by WNN.

As a congregation we participate in many other Mission and Ministry projects throughout the year. These acts of service are about our faithful devotion to the God who blesses us with His forgiveness, grace, and love.


