As a Reading, Grammar and Writing teacher for many years, this time of the year inspired many writing topics for me to use for my students. have only a few lines in which to write their response, however every few years I had a student that needed more than one pumpkin for their writing. They were graded using a list of requirements to make sure each student fully understood the topic and explained their reasons for being thankful. As I reflect on those writings many of the students were thankful for many things, but they couldn't explain why these things meant so much to them.

Are we, as the members of the Church body, any different? As young children and through our teenage years most of us were very thankful for our parents, grandparents, relatives, teachers and our pastors. We appreciated being fed, clothed, taught the Ten Commandments and the Lord's Prayer at church. I was especially grateful to my Sunday School teachers, along with my parents, that taught me the miracles, promises and the life of Jesus. I haven't stopped learning either! Each week as the Tuesday Bible Study group reads, discusses and dissects the weekly readings for clearer meaning, I am very thankful and grateful to each of the ladies in our group. I am very grateful for each one of you for the time, energy and love you give to our church. As I have grown older the things, I am grateful for aren't necessarily material things like my students wrote in their writings.

Our Gospel lesson this Sunday is from Matthew 5: 3-11-the Beatitudes, and I can't think of a better reading for the first Sunday of November. We don't often think of the poor, mourners, meek, hungry and persecuted as being thankful or appreciative. They will be rewarded when they enter the kingdom of God. Each of us faces different ordeals in life, and we know that our reward will be revealed in heaven.






