We're continuing with repairs on doors, locks, and lights throughout our facilities, with good progress being made. Thanks to Cecil McGouirk, Carla Stickles, Alaina Sperry, Rose Johnson, and others who have helped with these projects over the past several weeks.

Our prayer ministry outreach to our Macon Road business neighbors is underway. Thanks to Joyce and others who have been part of this ministry or expressed interest in doing so.

And thanks to the work of many hands, God's Work, Our Hands Sunday enabled us not only to reach out, but to share a meal together and dedicate the scripture quilt so many of you contributed to. Thanks especially to Linnea Grosse for continuing to lead this project.

We've resumed our weekly studies on Tuesday at 6 at Mr. Pizza, focusing on the Athanasian Creed.

So what about looking ahead?

We've approved a plan to install livestreaming equipment that will improve our reach to the world, an are now raising funds to support it. Watch for opportunities to give, including at Oktoberfest.

We'll shift our focus toward the gospel readings beginning October 15 through Christ the King Sunday. And we're in early planning for our stewardship campaign, our "regular" annual congregational meeting, and our special Advent services.

Our summer "on the go" has deepened and strengthened us in all three areas of our mission: Reaching in to grow in Christ; reaching up to worship God; and reaching out to welcome and witness." So, regardless of what we do with our clocks in November, we're well poised for a "fall forward!"


